

TSS PRINTER DRIVER

The Printer Driver is an interim program designed to allow the use of the line printer for listing large files. It will eventually be converted to run under the disk system.

The Printer Driver runs under the Bead and is called with the standard calling sequences.

`C, PRINTER, S, fname, user name`
and
`RECALL, PRINTER, CLASS, fname, user name`

where `fname, username` is are the file name and user name of the file to be printed.

Immediately after being called the Printer driver will ask whether the first character of each line should be interpreted as a scope carriage control character or not. If this action is desired type YES \odot . The printer driver looks for a Y in ~~col. 1~~ col. 1. Therefore Y \odot is equivalent to YES \odot while \odot YES \odot is not. The default option (ie, no Y in col. 1) will be single spacing with auto page eject, and ~~and~~ all characters ^{being} printed. The first character of each line being printed.
